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Course Content:

The operational specifics of the project and the learning objectives following from it will be negotiated and agreed during the Action Learning and Action Research Methodology workshops in BUMGT6963

Students will be required to undertake a project in a work/organisational setting that has the following characteristics:

Topics may include:

- it should address a 'real life' managerial problem to be solved (or opportunity to be grasped)
- it should require significant research and involve enough complexity and variety of stakeholders so as to preclude a simple technical solution
- the above notwithstanding, it should be amenable to achieving significant action within a five to six month time frame, and
- it should be in an organisational setting in which the student already has, or is confident of obtaining, a mandate for action.
